Art Camp Offerings

Art Camps for ages 7-14

Student Art Exhibits at the End of each Week!

Monday-Friday 9am-3pm (\$275 + \$10 material fee paid to instructor)

Extended time: 8:30 am - 3:30 pm (\$305+ \$10 extra per day.) We provide morning snack & drink. Students will need peanut-free brown bag lunch!

Week 1: Under the Sea// June 27 - July 1

This week's artistic exploration will take you from the crest of a wave to the deepest depths of the ocean floor to find inspiration in everything that floats, dives and swims!

Focus on drawing, painting and sculpture using a variety of materials such as colored pencils, paints markers and watercolors will be explored!

Week 2: Three Days of Paint Movie Parties - Half Day// For Ages 5-12 // July 6, 7, 8 9am-12pm, Cost :\$105

Use acrylic paints to create an 11"x14" canvas board painting each day, based on the theme of Disney movies. We will be painting images from the Up movie, Lion King and Little Mermaid!

Week 3: The Nuts and Bolts: Learn to Draw & Paint //July 11-15

Students will learn the basics of drawing and painting while exploring art styles of artists like Peter Max, Andy Warhol, Matisse and Sonia Delaunay to name a few. There will be a focus on observational drawing and color theory as well sing perspective to create form. Students will be introduced to new materials and techniques using a variety of new materials on canvas boards as well as other surfaces.

Week 4: Visit the 60's with Fashion! July 18-27

Visit the 6o's and design fashions inspired by the sounds of the Beatles, the art of Andy Warhol and bright colors of tie -dye! Students will create wearable designs and highlight their designs in their grand finale fashion show on Friday!

Week 5: Fun City Forms//July 25-29

Ever wanted to create your own city? Build your own tree house? This is your opportunity to learn about architecture, drawing, and building. We will be looking at city-scapes, buildings and bridge designs to

help us create our own structures. We will be using new tools, techniques and materials as well as being introduced to new artists. We will follow our imagination to create architectural sculptures in monumental proportions!

Week 6: Fashion Accessories//Aug 1-5

Design your own wearable flip -flops, canvas sneakers, head bands and t-shirt! Students will need to bring a white t-shirt, white canvas "Ked-like" sneakers and a pair of flip flops. The cheaper the purchase the better...we will be the designers!!!!

Week 7: Art Through Time//Aug 8-12

This week we will be inspired by our animal friends! We will be incorporating different parts of the animal world into our collage design paintings; animal relief prints and found object/cardboard sculptures. We will be exploring and experimenting with a variety of new and as well as familiar materials. Our art will feature different textures and patterns as well as including the unique color palette of the animal world.

Week 8: Nature in Art//Aug 15-19

Learn about the beautiful flower paintings of Georgia O'Keefe and be inspired to paint one of your own. Use watercolors to paint bugs and insects from representational images and from your imagination! Paint rocks and create a rock sculpture! Sand Paintings inspired from the Navajo will also be explored...so much to see and create from nature.

Week 9: Foods in Fashion//Aug 22-26

Foods will be the inspiration for the student's wearable fashion designs and soft sculptures this week. Students will design aprons that describe their favorite foods as well as soft sculptures inspired by the food sculptures of Claus Oldenburg! Their designs will be highlighted in their grand finale fashion show on Friday!

Week 1: Artsy Animals June 27, 29 & July 1

Learn how to draw animals using shapes and collage them like Eric Carle! Paint abstractly like an elephant using a "trunk"! Lastly, create your own found object sculpture of an animal like Pablo Picasso!

Week 2: Nature Exploration!

July 11, 13, 15

Paint Georgia O'Keefe inspired flowers and Eric Carle inspired butterflies! Learn about art of Andy Goldsworthy who used objects from nature to sculpt! Students will also be encouraged to think like scientists when they describe the colors, shapes and textures of nature objects in their hand made journals!

Week 3: City Life//July 18, 20, 22

Beep! Beep! Learn about the sounds and noises of a busy city when you explore the busy city life scenes in Romare Beardens's art! Students will create paintings and collages inspired by the many sights and sounds of the city. They will also explore architecture when they design sky scrapers for their imaginary city!

Week 4: Music Live

July25, 27, 29

How does music inspire art? Listen to the sounds of classical music with us and paint to find out! Students will be inspired by Wassily Kandinsky's musical composition paintings and the still life collage paintings of Pablo Picasso when they experiment with sounds of music in their drawings, paintings and sculptures!

Week 5: Five Days of Art Making Fun August 1, 2, 3, 4 & 5

9:00 - 12:00 (\$190 + 10 material fee paid to instructor)

Extended Care: 8:30 am - 12:30 pm (\$10 per day)

This five day camp is all about exploration of art materials and life in the sea! Each day our young artists will explore a new art medium! We will introduce them to drawing materials such as chalk and oil pastels. They will learn about watercolor paints and tempera paints. Lastly they will learn about modeling clay when they create sculptures!

Session for ages 7-11

Foundations: Drawing and Painting

This class is an introductory class to drawing and painting and sculpture! The students' lessons will focus on the design elements and principles of art, as well as drawing, painting and sculpting techniques. The students will be introduced to variety of drawing media (pencil,ink,pastels) and painting media (watercolor and acrylics) as they utilize the elements of designs and principles in their creative compositions!

Advanced Drawing and Painting
